President Trump vs. The Blob

• The Blob Wins

• Trump Wins (His radical *views* become *policy*)

• It's a Draw (Each side wins and loses some)

The Blob Wins

Structure > Agency

 Domestic Structure > Agency The Blob is formidable Lack of experts with Trump's views Checks and balances The Deep State
